The health of our campers, visitors, specialty groups, staff and volunteers is a top priority for us, and Camp Shady Brook has a long history of planning for and managing communicable diseases and other potential health/safety risks. Given the concerns pertaining to the Coronavirus (COVID-19), and the heightened risk for those with existing health conditions,

we wish to take the time to communicate our health-related plans and procedures to help all understand our preparedness.

Over the last couple of weeks, information regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19) has raised many concerns and we want you to know that we are committed to taking every possible precaution to minimize any risk within our camp facilities. We will continue to monitor information from national, state and local health officials on a regular basis.

Camp Shady Brook campers and staff are required to conduct a pre-camp and arrival day screening procedure that we implement each session, and we will update these health and wellness screening policies and procedures as needed to reflect the current best practices recommended by public health authorities.

In addition to our pre-camp screening, daily cleaning procedures are implemented by our staff. At the completion of camp sessions our staff disinfect all mattresses, deep clean bathrooms, bleach door handles, faucets and other high touch areas, remove any hazardous materials and ensure that living spaces are clean and ready for new campers.

We will continue to prepare for an amazing experience for you and your students. Please know if we should need to cancel a program because of the coronavirus, or any other medical epidemic, natural disaster, or other significant development, you will be reimbursed for your payments.
