WHAT IS RAD?

RAD was created in memory of Ryan Pappas, a Palmer Ridge High School Senior, who was killed as the result of a drunk driver on September 1, 2014. RAD is a student-based team that stands for sobriety in a fun, pressure-free environment.

HOW TO APPLY?

3. Please turn in the application package to the RAD teacher sponsor in your school, or a RAD leader.
*Applications will be accepted every Friday of every month.

LIVING THE RAD LIFESTYLE

RAD leaders are expected to live a drug and alcohol free lifestyle. RAD leaders must refrain from attending parties where drugs and/or alcohol are present. If a RAD leader finds him/herself in a space where drugs and alcohol are present, they are expected to leave immediately. Violation of this rule will call for removal from the leadership team.

The reputation of RAD among the student body is reliant on our leaders following this rule.

TIME COMMITMENT

RAD relies on its leaders to be at its events and meetings.

A typical week includes:

- RAD Club. Friday mornings at PR from 7:05-7:30 a.m. in the Sunset room, Friday mornings at LP at 7:20 a.m. in Mrs. Campbell's room
- RAD Night, Friday nights from 8:30-11:30 a.m. at the Teen Center of the Tri-Lakes YMCA.
- RAD biweekly meetings, Wednesdays from 7:00-8:00 p.m. at the Tri-Lakes YMCA.
