RAD was created in memory of Ryan Pappas, a Palmer Ridge High School Senior, who was killed as the result of a drunk driver on September 1, 2014. RAD is a student-based team that stands for sobriety in a fun, pressure-free environment.

HOW TO APPLY?

LIVING THE RAD LIFESTYLE

RAD leaders are expected to live a drug and alcohol free lifestyle. RAD leaders must refrain from attending parties where drugs and/or alcohol are present. If a RAD leader finds him/herself in a space where drugs and alcohol are present, they are expected to leave immediately. Violation of this rule will call for removal from the leadership team.

The reputation of RAD among the student body is reliant on our leaders following this rule.

TIME COMMITMENT

RAD relies on its leaders to be at its events and meetings.

A typical week includes:

- RAD Night, Friday nights from 8:00 11:00 a.m. at the Teen Center of the Tri-Lakes YMCA.
- RAD biweekly meetings, from 7:00 8:00 p.m. at the Tri-Lakes YMCA.

We understand that not everyone can attend every meeting because of other extracurricular activities, and personal life, but we ask you to please communicate with the RAD Secretary that you will be missing a meeting or RAD night.
