Rules: All play shall be governed by the USGA rules of golf except:

Play will be from the following tees:

- Men: Blue Tees
- 60+: White Tees
- Women: Red Tees

All ties will be determined by matching scorecards. The winner will be the team with the best score for holes #10 through #18. This is the USGA system for scorecard playoff.

Please hole out all putts that count for team score.

Contests: Longest Drive - Women & Men #10
Closest to the Pin - Women & Men #13

Awards: Winners in the following categories: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place for Men and Coed, Longest Drive Men and Longest Drive Women, closest to the Pin Men and Women.

Out of Bounds: Defined by white stakes and by permanent fences defining the exterior of the course Rule 27-1.

Environmentally Sensitive Areas- Defined by red stakes with green tops.
****DO NOT ENTER THE ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE AREAS ON THE FOLLOWING HOLES****
#2, #3, #4, #5, #8, #11, & #12

If your ball goes into these areas please play your ball as a Lateral Hazard.
Lateral Water Hazards: Defined by red lines or red stakes - Rule 26-1.

90 Degree Rule for Carts is in effect. Please keep carts out of all native grass.

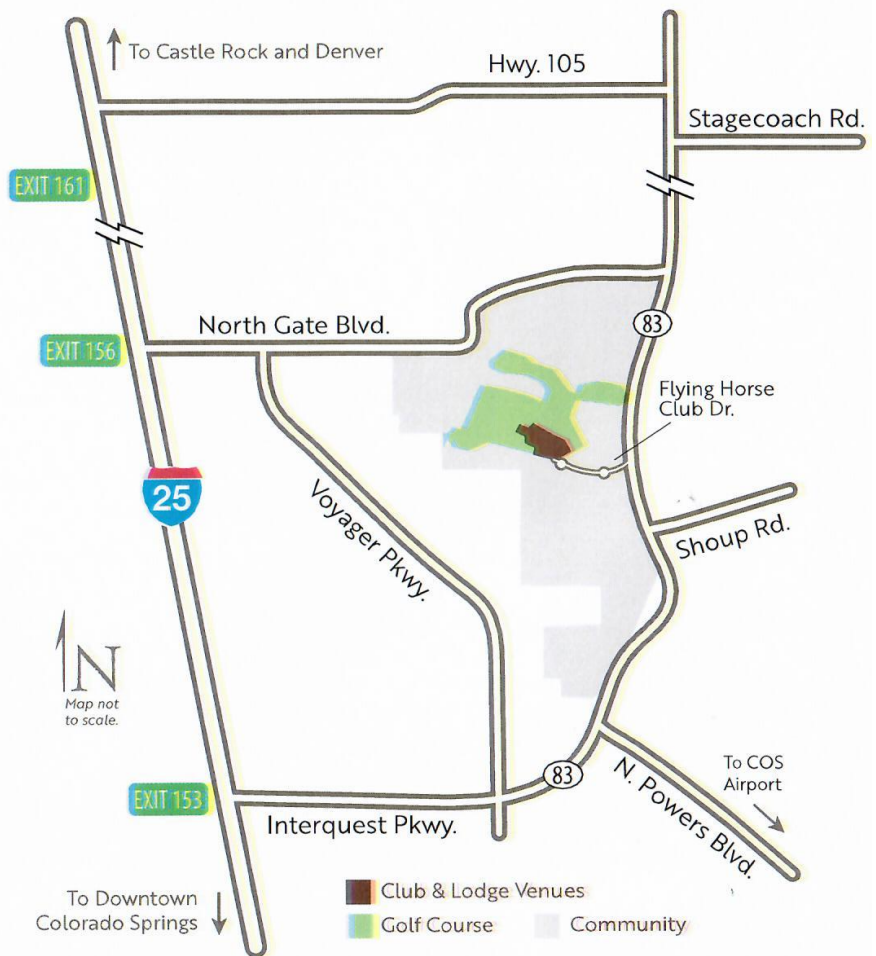


DIRECTIONS TO THE CLUB

From I-25 take Interquest Parkway exit 153. Continue on Interquest as it turns into Highway 83. Pass Shoup Road and turn left at the next light on Flying Horse Club Drive.

Go straight—you will pass through two roundabouts and reach the security gatehouse. Tell security that you are here for (name of your tournament). After entering you will veer to the right and turn in to the parking lot of The Club. The Clubhouse is the large building with the clock tower on the left-hand side.

The Barolo Ballroom and Fortezza Dining Room are located in our East Lodge building. The Milano, Turin, and Verona conference rooms are located in the West Lodge. Guestrooms are located in both the East and West Lodge buildings. The Villa suites, built around the resort's perimeter, are best located using the Property map on the next page.
